

24 JUNE: SOLEMNITY OF THE NATIVITY OF ST JOHN THE BAPTIST

Jesus said, "Among those born of women there has been none greater than John the Baptist" (Mt 11:11). Each year on June 24 the Catholic Church honors the birth of John by reflecting on his unique role as the precursor of Jesus. The solemnity praises John as a worthy example of

what it means to be a follower of Christ. The solemnity of the Nativity of John the Baptist is one of the Church's oldest celebrations and publicly observed as early as the fourth century. June 24 was chosen as the date for the solemnity because Scripture tells us that John was conceived six months before Jesus (Lk 1:36). Presumably, then, John was born about six months before Christ, and Christ's nativity was celebrated on Christmas Eve, Dec. 24.
