TODAY'S GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST MARK (Mark 7:1-8,14-15,21-23)

YOU PUT ASIDE THE COMMANDMENT OF GOD, TO CLING TO HUMAN TRADITIONS

The Pharisees and some of the scribes who had come from Jerusalem gathered round Jesus, and they noticed that some of his disciples were eating with unclean hands, that is, without washing them. For the Pharisees, and the Jews in general, follow the tradition of the elders and never eat without washing their arms as far as the elbow; and on returning from the market place they never eat without first sprinkling themselves. There are also many other observances which have been handed down to them concerning the washing of cups and pots and bronze dishes. So these Pharisees and scribes asked him, 'Why do your disciples not respect the tradition of the elders but eat their food with unclean hands?' He answered, 'It was of you hypocrites that Isaiah so rightly prophesied in this passage of scripture: This people honours me only with lip-service, while their hearts are far from me. The worship they offer me is worthless, the doctrines they teach are only human regulations. You put aside the commandment of God to cling to human traditions.' He called the people to him again and said, 'Listen to me, all of you, and understand. Nothing that goes into a man from outside can make him unclean; it is the things that come out of a man that make him unclean. For it is from within, from men's hearts, that evil intentions emerge: fornication, theft, murder, adultery, avarice, malice, deceit, indecency, envy, slander, pride, folly. All these evil things come from within and make a man unclean.'

UPGRADING OF CHURCH SOUND SYSTEM: The

Sound System in the Church is to be upgraded and the black loudspeakers in the Church will be replaced. A better system operation and audio sound will be guaranteed. We are grateful to an anonymous Donor who has donated the new Sound System to our parish. On behalf of the parish, I extend our heartfelt gratitude to this Donor and assure the family of our prayers. ROSARY GARDEN: The Grotto which was built 30 years ago in an area between the church and presbytery was generously funded by a Parishioner who today is still a parishioner at our Holy Spirit Church. The Grotto was in a good location because the curved brick wall of the church building (which was) facing the Grotto formed an arena that focused on Our Blessed Mother Mary's statue. However, following the construction of the Parish Centre in 2007 in the area facing the Grotto, the focus on our Blessed Mother Mary was lost, and that loss has continued to be felt through to today as the parish centre has blocked the open view focus on the Grotto. In addition to the lost focus, the Grotto itself has suffered deterioration over the years due to a poor foundation when it was built. Again, the affect(impact) of wind and rain over the last 30 years continues to cause the grounds around the Grotto to subside a little. Following recent storms, a major crack has opened all the way down the back of the Grotto's stonework, and unless rectified will probably collapse down the hill. Rather than trying to repair the Grotto, which may succeed after considerable expense but still lack the focus issue, I have seen an opportunity to rebuild the Grotto in a central position within the new proposed Rosary Garden, which would once again put the focus on the statue of our Blessed Mother Mary. I have previously made it known to all parishioners, the idea of having a befitting rosary garden in our parish in honour of our Blessed Mother Mary. This has been discussed both in the Parish Council and Finance Committee, and I have been talking to Parishioners about this. I feel now is the right time to actualise this dream of our Holy Spirit Church Rosary Garden with the Grotto at the focal point in the Rosary Garden. In order to create the area required for the Rosary Garden, I have agreed to give up a large portion of my unused (presbytery) backyard, by relocating the existing brushwood fence that runs up to the Grotto. Quotes from two landscapers for repairs to the Grotto, and the creation of the Rosary Garden came close to \$150,000, and after review, it was felt that members within our Parish Finance Committee had the skills to create the Rosary Garden, and this resulted in a Budget Estimate of \$50,000 to get the project completed all things being equal. A drawing showing the layout of the Rosary Garden will soon be on the pinup board in the church entrance(foyer). I am therefore appealing to you Parishioners for **DONATIONS** to the best of your ability to help our parish get this project done. I have got good news for you, and the good news is that I have recently received an anonymous donation of \$20,000 for the Rosary Garden and Grotto project. The donor wishes to remain anonymous. On behalf of the parish, I extend our heartfelt gratitude to this anonymous Donor and assure the family of our prayer for them in season and out of season. I commend you all parishioners to God through the motherly care of Our Blessed Virgin Mary.
