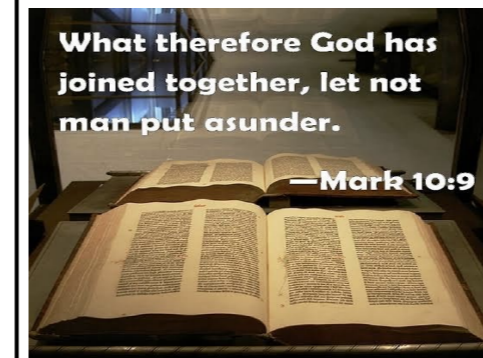

**TODAY'S GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST MARK (Mark 10:2-16)**

**WHAT GOD HAS UNITED, MAN MUST NOT DIVIDE**



What therefore God has  
joined together, let not  
man put asunder.

—Mark 10:9

Some Pharisees approached Jesus and asked, 'Is it against the law for a man to divorce his wife?' They were testing him. He answered them, 'What did Moses command you?' 'Moses allowed us' they said 'to draw up a writ of dismissal and so to divorce.' Then Jesus said to them, 'It was because you were so unteachable that he wrote this commandment for you. But from the beginning of creation God made them male and female. This is why a man must leave father and mother, and the two become one body. They are no longer two, therefore, but one body. So then, what God has united, man must not divide.' Back in the house the disciples questioned him again about this, and he said to them, 'The man who divorces his wife and marries another is guilty of adultery against her. And if a woman divorces her husband and marries another she is guilty of adultery too.' People were bringing

little children to him, for him to touch them. The disciples turned them away, but when Jesus saw this he was indignant and said to them, 'Let the little children come to me; do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs. I tell you solemnly, anyone who does not welcome the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it.' Then he put his arms round them, laid his hands on them and gave them his blessing.

**27<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading (Genesis 2:18-24)**

*A man and his wife become one body*

The Lord God said, ‘It is not good that the man should be alone. I will make him a helpmate.’ So from the soil the Lord God fashioned all the wild beasts and all the birds of heaven. These he brought to the man to see what he would call them; each one was to bear the name the man would give it. The man gave names to all the cattle, all the birds of heaven and all the wild beasts. But no helpmate suitable for man was found for him. So the Lord God made the man fall into a deep sleep. And while he slept, he took one of his ribs and enclosed it in flesh. The Lord God built the rib he had taken from the man into a woman, and brought her to the man. The man exclaimed: ‘This at last is bone from my bones, and flesh from my flesh! This is to be called woman, for this was taken from man.’ This is why a man leaves his father and mother and joins himself to his wife, and they become one body.

**POPE FRANCIS CALLS FOR A GLOBAL DAY OF PRAYER AND FASTING ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 7(OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY)**

Pope Francis has called for a *Global Day of Prayer and Fasting* to mark the one-year anniversary of the Hamas attack on Israel and in the face of the increasing conflict taking place in the Middle East. *He is asking all of us to take part in a day of Prayer and Fasting for peace in the world on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October 2024: Our Lady of the Rosary.* Pope Francis said the Church is always at the service of humanity especially in this dramatic hour of our history, as the winds of war and the fires of violence continue to ravage entire peoples and nations. The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference (ACBC) has also notified each diocese encouraging all to participate in this day of prayer and fasting. We also remember in your prayers all those attending the Synod on Synodality in Rome, especially our *Archbishop, Timothy Costelloe SDB.*

**PRAYER(to be said before the final blessing on the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary):**

O God, Trinity of love, from the profound communion of your divine life, pour out upon us a torrent of brotherly and sisterly love. Grant us the love reflected in the actions of Jesus, in his family of Nazareth, and in the early Christian community. Grant that we Christians may live the Gospel, discovering Christ in each human being, recognising him crucified in the sufferings of the abandoned and forgotten of our world, and risen in each brother or sister who makes a new start. Come, Holy Spirit, show us your beauty, reflected in all the peoples of the earth, so that we may discover anew that all are important, and all are necessary, different faces of the one humanity that God so loves, **AMEN.**

**OCTOBER, THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY [October Devotion: Pray Your Rosary Every Day]**

October is the month of the Rosary. We are invited to widen the horizon of our concerns and to embrace the world with the love of Mary, the mother of Jesus and our mother by saying our rosary every day this October. We do all for the Lord, with Mary our mother. Our love and our rosaries will go a long way in helping our missionary activities wherever we find ourselves. But much of the fruitfulness of our prayers will depend on the way we live. Mary, we give you our heart. Please set them on fire with love for Jesus. Make them always attentive to his burning thirst for love and for souls. Keep our hearts in your most pure Heart that we may love Jesus and the members of his Body with your own perfect love. Mary, we entrust ourselves totally to you: our body and soul, our goods, both interior and exterior, and even the value of all our good actions. Please make of us, of all that we are and have, whatever most pleases you. Let us be fit instrument in your immaculate and merciful hands for bringing the greatest possible glory to God. If we fall, please lead us back to Jesus. Let’s be washed in the blood and water that flow from your son’s pierced side, and help us never to lose our trust in this fountain of love and mercy. *With you, O Immaculate Mother, you who always do the will of God, we unite ourselves to the perfect consecration of Jesus as he offers himself in the Spirit to the Father for the life of the world, Amen.”*
