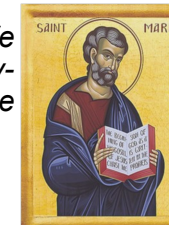

As Jesus left Jericho with his disciples and a large crowd, Bartimaeus (that is, the son of Timaeus), a blind beggar, was sitting at the side of the road. When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout and to say, 'Son of David, Jesus, have pity on me.' And many of them scolded him and told him to keep quiet, but he only shouted all the louder, 'Son of David, have pity on me.' Jesus stopped and said, 'Call him here.' So they called the blind man. 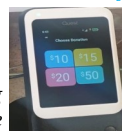

MASS READINGS

30TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

1st Reading (Jeremiah 31:7-9)

I will guide them by a smooth path where they will not stumble

The Lord says this: Shout with joy for Jacob! Hail the chief of nations! Proclaim! Praise! Shout: ‘The Lord has saved his people, the remnant of Israel!’ See, I will bring them back from the land of the North and gather them from the far ends of earth; all of them: the blind and the lame, women with child, women in labour: a great company returning here. They had left in tears, I will comfort them as I lead them back; I will guide them to streams of water, by a smooth path where they will not stumble. For I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim is my first-born son.

Every high priest has been taken out of mankind and is appointed to act for men in their relations with God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins; and so he can sympathise with those who are ignorant or uncertain because he too lives in the limitations of weakness. That is why he has to make sin offerings for himself as well as for the people. No one takes this honour on himself, but each one is called by God, as Aaron was. Nor did Christ give himself the glory of becoming high priest, but he had it from the one who said to him: You are my son, today I have become your father, and in another text: You are a priest of the order of Melchizedek, and for ever.

**MONTH OF NOVEMBER AND
NOVEMBER MASSES**

ALL SAINTS (SOLEMNITY): Friday is the 1st of November, the *Solemnity of All Saints*. There will be **THREE Masses** in the parish at **6:45am, 9:00am and 6:00pm**.

ALL SOULS: Saturday is the 2nd of November, the commemoration of “*All Souls – all the faithful departed*”. There will be **three Masses** in our parish: **6:45am Mass** (in the Church); **9:00am Mass** (in the Church); and **12:00pm Mass** (at the Columbarium outside the Adoration Chapel).

MONTH OF NOVEMBER CONT.

November is a special time to pray for the dead. A plenary indulgence may be gained for the dead, once only, by “*visiting a church on 2nd November, praying the Lord’s Prayer and the Creed*”. Three conditions are required for gaining the indulgence: *sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the Pope’s intentions*. Throughout the month of NOVEMBER, we commend to God all the souls in purgatory that He may soon bring them to His Glory, especially those of our relatives, friends, enemies, and those we are bound to pray for.

NOVEMBER MASS OFFERING ENVELOPES: The November Mass Offering Envelopes are available on the pews and in the foyer/Church entrance. *We ask you to fill them up and place them in the place provided in front of the altar or put the envelopes in the first or second collection bag or give it to the priest.* During this month of November in our parish, **THIRTY MASSES AND MORE** will be offered for all your loved ones who have died that you have requested Masses for by filling the November Mass envelopes. Your intentions are remembered at ALL MASSES throughout November as our thoughts and prayers turn to our relatives and friends who have died. Our faith tells us that our prayers and Masses can help these people whose faith is known to God alone. The month of November is therefore dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory. The Church commemorates all her faithful children who have departed from this life but have not yet attained the joys of heaven. St. Paul warns us that we must not be ignorant concerning the dead, nor sorrowful, "even as others who have no hope for the Lord Himself shall come down from heaven and the dead who are in Christ shall rise. The Church has always taught us to pray for those who have gone into eternity. Even in the Old Testament, prayers and alms were offered for the souls of the dead by those who thought "well and religiously concerning the resurrection." It was believed that "they who had fallen asleep with godliness had great grace laid up for them" and that "it is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins." We know that a defiled soul cannot enter into heaven. *Many blessings, Fr.Emmanuel-tv*
