# GO; YOUR FAITH HAS SAVED YOU

Take courage. Get up. Jesus is calling you. Mark 10:49

As Jesus left Jericho with his disciples and a large crowd, Bartimaeus (that is, the son of Timaeus), a blind beggar, was sitting at the side of the road. When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout and to say, 'Son of David, Jesus, have pity on me.' And many of them scolded him and told him to keep quiet, but he only shouted all the louder, 'Son of David, have pity on me.' Jesus stopped and said, 'Call him here.' So they called the blind man. 'Courage,' they said 'get up; he is calling you.' So throwing off his cloak, he jumped up and went to Jesus. Then Jesus spoke, 'What do you want me to do for you?' 'Rabbuni,' the blind man said to him 'Master, let me see again.' Jesus said to him, 'Go; your faith has saved you.' And immediately his sight returned and he followed him along the road.

#### MONTH OF NOVEMBER CONT.

November is a special time to pray for the dead. A plenary indulgence may be gained for the dead, once only, by "visiting a church on 2nd November, praying the Lord's Prayer and the Creed". Three conditions are required for gaining the indulgence: sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion, and praver for the Pope's intentions. Throughout the month of NOVEMBER, we commend to God all the souls in purgatory that He may soon bring them to His Glory, especially those of our relatives, friends, enemies, and those we are bound to pray for.
